## **TOUR ITINERARY**

# DAY 1: ARRIVAL AT SILANGIT AIRPORT - HUTA GINJANG - BALIGE - TB SILALAHI MUSEUM - THE CALDERA NOMADIC ESCAPE - PARAPAT - SAMOSIR (L/D)

Horas, Mejuah-juah! Upon arrival at Silangit Airport, you will be welcomed by our representative. The journey begins with a visit to Huta Ginjang, one of the best viewpoints of Lake Toba, located at 1,555 meters above sea level. Next, continue to Balige for lunch at a local restaurant. After lunch, visit TB Silalahi Museum, which showcases historical artifacts from the six Batak sub-ethnic groups: Toba, Simalungun, Karo, Mandailing, Angkola, and Pakpak. The complex also features a gallery and souvenir shop selling Batak handicrafts and traditional "Ulos" fabric.

Continue to The Caldera Nomadic Escape in Sibisa, a popular destination for its scenic Lake Toba backdrop. Capture your best moments here before heading to Parapat, then take a ferry across Lake Toba to Samosir Island. Upon arrival, enjoy dinner at a local restaurant, then check-in at the hotel and rest.









# DAY 2: SAMOSIR TOUR - AMBARITA VILLAGE - BATU HODA BEACH - SIBEA-BEA HILL -EFRATA WATERFALL - HOLBUNG HILL (B/L/D)

After breakfast, begin your tour by visiting Ambarita Village to see the ancient stone execution chairs made by King Siallagan. You'll also have the chance to perform the traditional Batak dance with Sigale-gale statue. Continue to Tomok Village to see the centuriesold Tomb of King Sidabutar and his stone-carved tombstone.

Next, cross Tano Ponggol Bridge, which connects Samosir Island to mainland Sumatra. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant, then visit Lumban Suhi-suhi Village and Hutaraja Village to see traditional Ulos weaving. Head to Batu Hoda Beach, known as the zero-point of Samosir Island, for relaxation and photos.

Continue to Sibea-Bea Hill for stunning views of Lake Toba and its winding scenic roads – a favorite photo spot. Visit Efrata Waterfall, known for its cliff-carved appearance, and finish the day at Holbung Hill, filming location of the famous Indonesian movie Ngeri-Ngeri Sedap and one of the best spots to enjoy panoramic views of Lake Toba and Samosir Island. Dinner at a local restaurant, then return to the hotel to rest.

# DAY 3: SAMOSIR - TELE VIEW TOWER - TONGGING - LOKEN BARN - SAPO JUMA -ORANGE PICKING - BERASTAGI (B/L/D)

After breakfast and hotel check-out, head to Tele View Tower, one of the best places to admire the legendary Lake Toba. Continue to Tongging, and visit the European-style Loken Barn Resort with Lake Toba as its backdrop. Proceed to Sipiso-piso Waterfall, a 120meter high scenic waterfall.

Enjoy lunch at a floating restaurant by the lake, featuring grilled fish and beautiful mountain views. Afterward, visit Sapo Juma, known as the "Garden of a Thousand Flowers" overlooking Lake Toba. Continue to Dokan Village for a fun orange-picking experience, then drive to Berastagi. Upon arrival, explore the Fruit Market, one of the largest fresh produce markets in North Sumatra. Dinner at a local restaurant, check in at the hotel, and rest.









## DAY 4: BERASTAGI - LUMBINI PAGODA - MEDAN CITY TOUR (B,L,D)

After breakfast and hotel check-out, visit the golden Lumbini Pagoda, the tallest pagoda in Indonesia and a replica of Myanmar's Shwedagon Pagoda, recognized with two MURI records. Then drive to Medan.

Upon arrival, visit the iconic Maimun Palace, a grand legacy of the Deli Sultanate with its distinctive yellow color and Malay architecture. (Optional: Dress in traditional Malay royal costumes for a photo session at your own expense.) Lunch at a local restaurant.

Continue to Annai Velangkanni Church, a unique Catholic church with Indian temple-style architecture. Next, visit Kaos Jegez, a shop selling North Sumatran-themed souvenirs. Dinner at a local restaurant. You will also have the option to stop by the famous Medan Durian stalls (own expense), before checking in at your hotel for rest and free time.
